They kept to themselves and talked only when prompted to do so. On arrival Jane was 9 years old, weighing 34 lbs and Veronica the age of 6, weighed 26.5 lbs. Comparing then and now, they have made tremendous improvement. They smile all the time, play with others both at school and at home, freely express themselves, work easily on their schoolwork and increased in weight too. Jane currently weighs 53 lbs. and Veronica weighs 37 lbs.
