Friends, there are moments in ministry that break your heart. And then there are moments that remind you why God has called us to this work in the first place. Recently, we experienced both.

A little over seven years ago, a tiny one-year-old boy named Sammy arrived at Tobiah Home fighting for his life.

Malnourished, underweight, weak, and in desperate need of love and care, Sammy found a family at Tobiah Home. Because of faithful supporters like you, he received nutritious food, medical care, and the safety every child deserves. Slowly, he grew into a healthy, happy little boy.

Three years ago, when Sammy's mother was released from prison, he returned home to live with her as the courts ordered, in hopes they could build a new life together.

Sadly, that hope was short-lived.

We recently learned Sammy suffered abuse, was left alone, often went without food, and was unable to attend school. Peter and Maryanne (house parents), were heartbroken and would not rest until they could legally bring Sammy back to Tobiah Home.

Today, we are grateful to share that Sammy is back at Tobiah Home again. Please join Sammy, Peter, Maryanne, and Sammy's Tobiah Home siblings in celebrating his return!

He is safe. He is loved. He has food on the table, a bed to sleep in, and at seven years old, he will finally begin school.

Now, Sammy needs someone to stand beside him once again.

It costs \$200 each month to provide a child at Tobiah Home with food, clothing, education, medical care, and the love of a Christian family.

Would you prayerfully consider becoming Sammy's sponsor?

If a full sponsorship isn't possible, many of our children are supported by two or more families who share the monthly cost.

Sammy isn't the only child waiting. Enclosed, you'll meet four other wonderful children who also need sponsors.
